




Message from the Chairman

Strengthening U.S.-Jordan Economic Ties at the 2025 SelectUSA Investment Summit



Washington, D.C., May 11-14, 2025 – As part of its ongoing efforts to promote bilateral trade & investment between Jordan and the United States, AmCham-Jordan actively supported and participated in the 2025 SelectUSA Investment Summit, held from May 11–14 in Washington, D.C.

In preparation for the Summit, AmCham-Jordan, in collaboration with the Foreign Commercial Service at the U.S. Embassy in Amman, hosted an informational session on March 26, 2025, to brief member companies on investment

opportunities in the U.S. and the benefits of participating in SelectUSA. The session provided insights into the Summit’s investment incentives, networking opportunities, and tailored programming.

Represented by Chairman Samer S. Judeh and CEO Raghad Alkhozah, AmCham-Jordan joined the official Jordanian delegation organized by the Foreign Commercial Service at the U.S. Embassy in Amman, which included several member companies and aimed to connect Jordanian businesses with investment opportunities across all 50 U.S. states. AmCham-Jordan held a series of high-level meetings with officials from the U.S. Department of State and the Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) and hosted a roundtable at the U.S. Chamber of Commerce to facilitate direct engagement with SelectUSA experts, U.S. business leaders, and key stakeholders.

The delegation also took part in regional networking engagements with Gulf and MENA representatives, reinforcing cross-regional collaboration. AmCham-Jordan’s participation reflects its continued commitment to supporting Jordanian businesses in accessing U.S. markets and advancing bilateral trade and investment.

Empowering Jordanian Companies at PLMA 2025 in Chicago



Chicago, November 16–18, 2025 – AmCham-Jordan supported the successful participation of Jordanian companies at the PLMA 2025 U.S. Private Label Trade Show, one of the world's largest private-label exhibitions, featuring more than 1,900 exhibitors from 60 countries. Represented by CEO Raghad AlKhojah, AmCham-Jordan provided technical support to the three exhibiting companies: Zalloum Bros Company, Regional Plastic Packages Co. Ltd., and Habibeh (Al Bandar Group). Through AmCham-Jordan's facilitation, the participating companies engaged in high-value B2B meetings, explored new export and investment opportunities, and strengthened their visibility in the global private-label supply chain. The companies expressed satisfaction with their participation, noting the valuable connections and business insights gained at the event.

This participation underscores AmCham-Jordan's commitment to expanding market access for Jordanian businesses, enhancing their competitiveness, and positioning Jordan as a reliable partner for U.S. and international markets.

The summit provided a platform to promote Jordan's economic strengths, attract partnerships, and explore new opportunities for regional growth. Ms. AlKhojah emphasized AmCham-Jordan's role in highlighting Jordan as a gateway for trade and investment and fostering collaboration among AmChams in the region. Her participation reaffirmed the Chamber's commitment to supporting cross-border partnerships and contributing to shared economic prosperity across the wider Eurasian business community.

Joint initiatives will promote sustainable growth, innovation, and alignment with Jordan's Economic Modernization Vision, reflecting a shared commitment to entrepreneurship, cross-border collaboration, and inclusive development.

Renewing Strategic Partnership with MPG



Amman, April 9, 2025 – AmCham-Jordan renewed its partnership agreement with The Multinational Pharmaceutical Company Group (MPG), the leading biopharmaceutical companies operating in Jordan. The agreement, signed by Chairman Mr. Samer S. Judeh and MPG Chair Mr. Rami Nassar, reinforces a decade-long collaboration focused on innovation, sustainability, and sectoral development. The renewal aims to strengthen cooperation, enhance governance, and support impactful initiatives across the health and pharmaceutical industries. Building on the success of the 2015 agreement, it marks a milestone in advancing Jordan's healthcare ecosystem and promoting U.S.–Jordan collaboration in innovation and economic growth. It also highlights shared priorities, including regulatory alignment, responsible market growth, talent development, and improved patient access, while maintaining platforms for dialogue with stakeholders nationwide.

He shared insights on how AI is transforming global finance and markets. The event, attended by H.E. Mr. Muhannad Shehadeh, AmCham members, and Citi partners, explored AI’s growing role in financial innovation and economic competitiveness. In opening remarks, Chairman Mr. Samer Judeh emphasized the importance of connecting the private sector with global experts, while Ms. Nour Jarrar, CEO of Citi Jordan, highlighted AI’s impact on efficiency and growth.

She emphasized the region's potential as a hub for innovation and offered practical advice for startups on scaling, partnerships, and global expansion.

Alkhojah also highlighted key support networks, AmCham-Jordan, SelectUSA, Fulbright, and TechWomen, while addressing the importance of localization, data security, and sustainability. Gathering 70 alumni from across MENA, the workshop fostered collaboration and showcased Jordan's innovation ecosystem, reaffirming AmCham-Jordan's commitment to empowering future business leaders and strengthening U.S.–Jordan ties.





Participation at the National Forum for Wood and Furniture Industries

Amman, September 2, 2025 – AmCham-Jordan, represented by its CEO Ms. Raghad Alkhozah, attended the First Forum for Wood, Furniture, and Kitchen Industries, organized by the Jordan Chamber of Industry in collaboration with the Jordanian Furniture Exporters and Producers Association. During the forum, Ms. Alkhozah delivered a speech on behalf of AmCham-Jordan, highlighting the Chamber’s role in supporting the sector and fostering collaboration between local and international stakeholders.

The event, held under the patronage of the Minister of Industry, Trade and Supply, brought together key industry leaders to discuss the sector’s growth, export performance, and major challenges, including high operational costs, skilled labor shortages, and export limitations.

AmCham-Jordan Highlights Key Insights at Better Work Jordan 2025

Amman, June 2, 2025 – AmCham-Jordan played a key role in the 2025 Better Work Jordan Multi-Stakeholders’ Forum, themed “BWJ’s 15 Years of Impact: A Future-Oriented Celebration.” Oula Ayyoub, Head of the Jordan–U.S. FTA Unit and Business Development at AmCham-Jordan, participated in a panel on maximizing the garment sector’s potential under the Jordan–U.S. Free Trade Agreement, noting that trade with the U.S. remains vital for growth and employment, despite challenges like limited diversification, rising compliance demands, and regional competition. She emphasized the need for stronger public–private coordination and highlighted AmCham-Jordan’s role in promoting U.S.–Jordan trade and investment.



The forum also marked 15 years of Better Work Jordan, an ILO flagship program that has expanded formal employment, particularly for women, demonstrating the impact of strategic collaboration in the industry.

The workshop demonstrated how science-based behavioral insights can enhance decision-making, drive growth, and strengthen Jordan’s private sector competitiveness through global expertise and practical application.

AmCham-Jordan Aggregator Accelerator Program Implemented under the Informal Livelihoods Advancement Activity (Iqlaa)

Program Overview

The Aggregator Accelerator Program aims to enhance the market presence and competitiveness of Jordanian MSEs and HBBs by supporting the growth of ten promising aggregators across key sectors, including design, handicrafts, cultural heritage, e-commerce, sports and youth development, agriculture, and home décor.

At its core, the Program promotes a deeper understanding of the aggregator business model and encourages its adoption across various value chains. Through a structured, multi-phase technical assistance approach, participating aggregators receive support to refine their models and expand their market reach.

The Program launched with a comprehensive study that explored global best practices and assessed how aggregation models could be adapted to Jordan's market dynamics.

Following this, selected aggregators participated in an intensive five-day training program featuring tailored coaching and technical guidance to strengthen their business models.

Progress in 2025

Despite challenges to the original timeline, the Program maintained continuous support throughout the year.

The first phase concluded successfully with a full assessment of each aggregator's organizational capabilities, identifying capacity gaps and providing actionable recommendations for improvement.



Looking Ahead

In the coming year, the focus will shift toward translating the refined aggregator concepts into market-ready strategies.
